Flight MK 057 from London

Flight MK 057 which was originally scheduled to leave London on Wednesday 08 December at 20h00 was rescheduled to leave London on Thursday 09 December at 19h00.

Following additional work required on the aircraft and performed by Virgin Atlantic engineers (our engineers in London), the flight is now further delayed and is now scheduled to leave London today the 10th of December at 15h00. The flight is expected to reach Mauritius on the 11th of December at 07h00.

Passengers have been accommodated at Sofitel Gatwick airport as there was no hotel available in the vicinity of Heathrow airport following the chaos caused to air traffic by the snow in Europe.

Air Mauritius apologies for all inconvenience caused by this delay and reiterates that safety of its passengers and crew remains its topmost priority.
