Air Mauritius will increase its fuel surcharge for tickets issued on or after the 16th of March 2011 as a result of the sustained escalation of the price of fuel.

The new levels represent an increase of 2 Euros to 15 Euros per sector.

The airline will continue to monitor fuel prices and keep surcharges under constant review.
