Climatic Conditions in Europe continue to cause major disruptions to flights

London Heathrow airport and Paris Charles de Gaulle airport have opened but with severe restrictions on all airline operations.

MK6057 departed London Heathrow this morning with 4 hours delay and is now expected to land in Mauritius at 15:50.

MK048 of 20th December scheduled for Frankfurt and Geneva could not land in Frankfurt and was diverted to Geneva. The flight will take off today 21st December at 09:00 from Geneva and is expected to land in Mauritius at 22:55.

Passengers booked on MK046 of the 21st December will now fly on MK2046 of 22nd December at 09:45.
