Air Mauritius maintains its operation to Europe

All Air Mauritius flights into Europe are operating as scheduled since the start of volcanic activities of Grimsvotn in Iceland - all European airports served by Air Mauritius being operational.

The Air Mauritius Operation Control Centre (OCC) and Station Managers (based in London, Paris, Frankfurt, Geneva and Milan) are liaising with the local airport authorities in order to obtain regular updates and are constantly monitoring the situation.
