University of Mauritius runs Management Development Programme for Air Mauritius

Air Mauritius in association with the University of Mauritius launched on Friday 14th May a Management Development Programme customized for the airline's managers.

The course will be run over a period of six months and consists of seven modules made up of formal training as well as action learning which will cover a wide range of management subjects. A first group of about 20 managers have enrolled for this programme.
